Revise a course:

NEW: COMM 205 COMMUNICATION PRACTICUM (2, max 4) Students address communication issues in a field setting. They will evaluate communication practices using interview methodology. Projects are jointly evaluated by internship supervisor and professor. Open to communication majors only. Graded CR/NC. Prerequisite: COMM 200; recommended preparation: sophomore standing.

OLD: COMM 205 SUMMER COMMUNICATION PRACTICUM (2, max 4, Sm) [Description, registration restriction, grading, and preparation same as above.]

II. MARSHALL SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

Revise the prerequisites of 2 courses:

A. BUAD 302 COMMUNICATION STRATEGY IN BUSINESS (4, FaSpSm) Theory, practice, and techniques of business communication strategy essential to external and organizational communication; group and interpersonal communication; development of skill in oral and written communication.
