I. SCHOOL OF CINEMATIC ARTS: Writing for Screen and Television Req. by Michael Renov

Revise a course

Eff. Term: Fall 2007

CTWR-516 Advanced Motion Picture Script Analysis (2, FaSp)

NEW: Critical analysis of the structure of films from the classics to current award winners. Students will learn how to identify key story concepts and break down three act structure in finished films and scripts.

OLD: Detailed evaluation of completed scripts prior to their production; evaluation of existing classic scripts. (2 or 4, FaSp)

APPROVED. Request is to change unit value from 2 or 4 to just 2, not repeatable. Also they're changing the catalogue description. This course is not listed as a 4-unit course anywhere in the listings of required or elective courses so no catalogue changes in program requirements should be necessary.

II. COLLEGE OF LETTERS ARTS & SCIENCES: Linguistics

Reduce the number of required units from 33 to 32 to accommodate revision of required MUHL 572 from 3 to 2 units.

Reduce the number of required units by one and increase the number of elective units by one to accommodate revision of required MUHL 572 from 3 to 2 units.

Change title, catalogue description and unit value from 3 to 2,

NEW: Seminar in Historical Musical Notation (2). Performing, reading, and editing historical notation from original sources. Prerequisite: MUHL-570.

OLD: Seminar in Notation (3). Musical notation of the Middle Ages, the Renaissance, and Baroque; transcriptions and scoring. Text abbreviations and translations; editorial practice. Problems of modern notation. Prerequisite: MUHL 570.
